### EXPLANATION

This policy was revised as follows:

- Provide clarity to the scope of oversight required as it relates to covered agents and toxins and removing the section other agents and toxins section
- Update the contact information from the Research Integrity & Compliance Review Office (RICRO) to the Office of Research Collaboration and Compliance (ORCC)
- Designate the Institutional Contact for Dual Use Research (ICDUR) to serve as an internal resource for issues regarding compliance
- Establish a new process for the creation of the Institutional Review Entity (IRE)

University partners involved in the discussion included: Linda Schutjer, Senior Legal Counsel; Joanie Ryan, Assistant Biosafety Officer; Christine Johnson, Senior IBC Coordinator; and Rebecca Moritz, Biosafety Office Director. Additionally, stakeholder feedback was requested from the Council of Research Associate Deans; Deans, Directors, and Department heads listserv; and the Office of the Vice President for Research Executive Team and Division Directors. 
